

HELLO,

The year 2020 was significant for all of us, including the persecuted church. I heard many saying it was going to be the year of perfect vision. Instead, it was a year with challenges none of us saw coming. Christians the world over wrestled with how best to follow Jesus in uncertainty.

In the most dangerous places to follow Jesus, Christians faced increased persecution as many of them were denied access to aid and medical support because of their faith in Jesus.

And the Western expression of faith was thrown into chaos as we learnt what it meant to trust Jesus when we're not in control of our surroundings.

Many of us were left questioning whether our understanding of faith inadvertently found its baseline in safety and comfort. But could it be, we are finally coming to realise that suffering is not so much a betrayal of the gospel, but the essence of it?

It's something the persecuted church have been teaching us for decades as they have been running churches in their own kind of 'lockdown' for years. 2020 gave us more capacity to understand what Christians all over the world experience on a daily basis as they live out their faith with externally forced restrictions.

But even in a time of great difficulty, you went above and beyond and helped our brothers and sisters navigate both persecution and pandemic. Because of your support over the last year, we were able to raise more money than ever before to strengthen and respond to the needs of the persecuted church.

Thank you for your generosity! I hope this Impact Report shows you the significant part you play in the body of Christ, and how we can continue to learn from the persecuted church as we follow Jesus, no matter the cost.

DISCIPLESHIP



You helped 6,673,698 people follow Jesus by strengthening their faith, providing Bibles and equipping them to share the gospel.

Building strong disciples of Jesus is the cornerstone of our mission. Through our local partners, your support has strengthened the faith of persecuted believers, helping them follow Jesus by

giving them exactly what they need to do so. But what does that look like?

In 2020, you helped build Christian libraries and book shops.

EMERGENCY RELIEF



You helped 808,092 people follow Jesus, even in the most dangerous places, as they faced persecution, poverty, and war.

In a year when crisis became the new normal, you delivered food and medicine to those in desperate need, especially during COVID-19. You ran trauma counselling sessions for those who had been attacked or kidnapped. You provided families with safe havens to flee from war and violence. And you created awareness about what the persecuted church endure for their faith.

Across Asia, many Christians have been denied access to medical support and emergency relief because of their faith in Jesus In India, Open Doors' partners delivered emergency relief to over 126,000 people who had been impacted by COVID-19. In Nepal and Sri Lanka, you helped distribute packages of soap, rice, dahl, biscuits, and milk to families who lost their income due to the pandemic.

One of our local church partners in India, Pastor Nihal,* was on the ground, making sure your generous support reached those families who needed it most. "I've never seen them so happy," he said. "Some of these children have not tasted milk in years because their parents can't afford it. Thank you for helping us."



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT



You helped 290,950 people follow Jesus by giving them the tools to stay in their communities and be the light of Christ.

You gave training and job opportunities to believers facing discrimination and persecution. You helped parents send their children to school. You made sure Christians had access to clean and safe drinking water.

You gave Christians access to job training so they could provide for their families. You provided legal assistance to victims of persecution. And you ran literacy classes to help believers find work and understand the Word of God.

For Stephen,* following Jesus in Laos nearly cost him everything. But, because of faithful supporters like you, Stephen and his family were able to stay in their community and make a difference.

You helped support them as they sheltered new Christians experiencing persecution. Stephen's wife was also given literacy training and now helps teach other Christians to read in their village.

"There are times when I feel like the world is against me," Stephen shared. "But God sent people. He used Open Doors."



YOU MADE A DIFFERENCE FOR HANNAH

If you were a Christian living in Central Asia, the government would suppress every aspect of your Christian life. You could be arrested for showing "suspicious" religious behaviour and would be forced to follow Jesus in secret. Persecution could come from anywhere, even from within your own family.

When Hannah* decided to follow Jesus, the persecution came quickly. Her husband started to beat her, trying to get her to renounce her Christian faith. But she refused to give up on Jesus.

Hannah's husband kicked her and their two children out of their home. They had nowhere to live and no way to support themselves.

But that's where you came in.

Through your generosity, Hannah received assistance to begin building a new house. You provided her with food, gas, and a stove to make sure her two kids didn't go hungry.

Hannah's life looks different today, thanks to you. Thank you for helping people like her follow Jesus in the most dangerous places. Because of you, the future of faith looks bright for the persecuted church.

Here are just three of the ways you practically strengthened the Church.




You provided microloans and job training for 1,633 believers, empowering them to provide sustainable income to support their families.



WHERE YOUR MONEY WENT IN 2020

WHERE MOST NEEDED

You Sent \$3,649,373

Persecution is not predictable; it can happen at any time and can look different all over the world. Our Where Most Needed Fund allows us to equip our local partners to best meet the needs of local believers suffering discrimination and persecution, where and when it is most needed.

In 2020, you made a huge difference for persecuted Christians who desperately needed it most.

Even with borders shut and travel restricted, by allocating resources to 'Where Most Needed' we were able to ensure your generous gifts were used as soon as possible in countries our partners could reach.

During the pandemic, you helped us respond immediately to families suffering from a lack of medical support in India. You provided persecuted Christian nurses with the correct PPE to keep them safe in COVID wards.

And when lockdowns hit families hard in Central Asia, our local partners could visit with food supplies.



AFRICA You Sent \$144,192



1 in 6 Christians in Africa are persecuted for their faith. In countries like Nigeria, Burkina Faso and Cameroon, the church is facing more violence and extremism than ever before.

In 2020, you, together with others like you, provided counselling for trauma survivors, funded microloans for struggling families, and gave hope to women widowed through extremist attack – and that's just the beginning.

MIDDLE EAST & NORTH AFRICA

You Sent \$165,437



Persecution, poverty, conflict, and the pandemic have made Christians in this region extremely vulnerable. In 2020, lockdowns forced many new Christians back into the homes of Muslim families who persecuted them. In some places, Christian doctors and nurses were forced to run COVID-19 clinics with no protective equipment.

But you made a difference. From smuggling Bibles and discipling new Christians, to starting businesses and delivering emergency relief, you helped people follow Jesus, no matter the cost.

ASIAYou Sent \$133,617



2 in 5 Christians in Asia face persecution and discrimination – the highest proportion of any region. While some nations monitor churches, other countries have outlawed them and detain anyone suspected of following Jesus.

In 2020, your support ensured believers excluded from aid distributions received the food and medicine they needed. You empowered Christians exiled by their communities to be self-sufficient and made sure they received training and equipment to build a sustainable income.

CENTRAL ASIA

You Sent \$67,300



Across Central Asia, authorities suppress all Christian activity, monitoring and arresting anyone showing "suspicious" religious behaviour. In some parts of the region, it is even illegal to share the gospel with anyone under the age of 16.

But in 2020, you made a difference. You sent Bibles and provided Christian training. You started businesses and provided food to those struggling to survive lockdowns. You even gave vulnerable children safe spaces to learn about Jesus.
